



## Thrillin' Grillin' Raffle Official House Rules

These Official House Rules govern the conduct of the 2026 Thrillin' Grillin' Raffle. This document must be available where tickets are sold.

This raffle is conducted pursuant to a raffle license issued by the State of Michigan, Bureau of State Lottery, Charitable Gaming Division. In the event of any conflict between these Official House Rules and the raffle license, the terms of the raffle license shall govern.

The 2026 Thrillin' Grillin' Raffle Prize is a Blackstone Grill and accessories (approximate retail value: \$700).

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS TO ENTRANTS OF A BLACKSTONE GRILL AND ACCESSORIES RAFFLE BENEFITING ALLIANCE CATHOLIC FOUNDATION INC

All entrants of the Thrillin' Grillin' Raffle benefiting the Alliance Catholic Foundation Inc ("Raffle") must be at least 18 years of age.

Raffle tickets may only be sold to, and completed by, persons physically present within the State of Michigan.

By entering the Raffle, you agree that you have read, understood, and are bound by these Terms and Conditions.

The raffle begins on Monday, June 1, and will conclude on Tuesday, June 30. The drawing date will be Wednesday, July 15, at 2:00 p.m., as approved in the raffle license issued by the State of Michigan.

All Raffle entrants understand and agree that they are entering for a chance to win a Blackstone grill and accessories prize package. Each \$10 Raffle ticket represents one Raffle entry. There is no limit to how many tickets may be purchased at a time or per person. Tickets are non-refundable.

A drawing selecting the Raffle winner will be recorded and witnessed by no fewer than two Alliance Catholic Foundation Operational Committee members.

Present employees, volunteers, and affiliates of the Alliance Catholic Foundation Inc and Alliance Catholic Credit Union, and immediate family members of present employees, volunteers, and affiliates of Alliance Catholic Foundation Inc / Alliance Catholic Credit Union,



are ineligible to enter. "Immediate family member" means a spouse, domestic partner, child, grandchild, parent, grandparent, or sibling (including adoptive, in-law, and step-relationships).

You may enter by purchasing tickets at a branch location or through the contact center. Tickets purchased through the contact center will be set aside at the branch location of your choosing and must be filled out in person.

Raffle tickets may not be sold online, mailed, or sold or fulfilled outside the State of Michigan.

The prize will be held until a valid winning entry is selected. A drawing selecting the Raffle winner will be conducted by at least two members of the Alliance Catholic Foundation Operational Committee on the date and time approved by the State of Michigan, Bureau of State Lottery, Charitable Gaming Division, as stated in the raffle license.

The winner agrees to report to the Alliance Catholic Credit Union headquarters in Farmington Hills, Michigan, to provide valid identification and complete any necessary forms required before the winner may receive the prize. If the winner does not complete and return the required documentation within the third business day of notification, a new winner will be selected.

The prize must be accepted as awarded and is non-transferable and not redeemable for cash. Alliance Catholic Foundation Inc reserves the right to substitute the prize with one of equal or greater value only as permitted by the raffle license.

The prize may be considered taxable income. The winner is responsible for any federal, state, or local taxes associated with the prize and should consult a tax advisor regarding any potential tax implications.

Further, the winner hereby agrees to indemnify and hold Alliance Catholic Foundation Inc and Alliance Catholic Credit Union harmless from any and all liability related to the Raffle and/or the prize, and agrees not to hold Alliance Catholic Foundation Inc and Alliance Catholic Credit Union liable for any action derived from the use, transport, or enjoyment of the prize.

It is the responsibility of the entrant to comply with any federal laws or regulations as well as any laws specific to the state or locality in which the entrant resides. In the event of a conflict between the Official House Rules of this Raffle and Michigan law, Michigan law shall prevail and, if applicable, the raffle license shall control.



By entering the Raffle, you grant to Alliance Catholic Foundation Inc and Alliance Catholic Credit Union a non-exclusive, worldwide, paid-up, royalty-free license to use your likeness and name in perpetuity in any future publications, which may include appearing on their website.

Alliance Catholic Foundation Inc or Alliance Catholic Credit Union reserves the right to refuse an entry and/or disqualify a winner, in its sole discretion, if it determines that any of these Official House Rules or the terms of the raffle license are not met.

No portion of the Raffle ticket price is considered a charitable contribution for purposes of tax deductibility.

Net proceeds benefit the Alliance Catholic Foundation Inc.

Net proceeds will be used solely for lawful charitable purposes in accordance with Michigan charitable gaming laws and regulations.

All raffle records, including ticket stubs, sales records, and financial documentation, will be maintained for the period required by Michigan law and will be made available for inspection by the Michigan Bureau of State Lottery, Charitable Gaming Division, upon request.
